

# ICENES-2000 Template for MS-Word-97

## Abstract

This is the template for writing papers for ICENES-2000 using MS-Word-97 (or –2000). All papers are requested to follow the guidelines described below. The text file should be submitted to the Conference Secretariat [hofman@nrg-nl.com](mailto:hofman@nrg-nl.com) by electronic mail, as attached file in pdf format. Please note that we require authors to convert their papers to pdf files that can be opened by Acrobat 4.0 Reader without displaying any error messages. Deadline is June 1, 2000. Proceedings will be published both as book and on CDROM. This section (Abstract) is obligatory in the paper.

## 1. Introduction

This section (Introduction) is the first part of the paper and is obligatory too. It should include the purpose of the paper and contain adequate references to earlier work in the field.

## 2. Paper formatting

The MS-Word-97 template provides the format specifications, just type replacing these lines to write your paper. If you are using another word processor you must strictly adhere to the following rules:

Paper size: A4 (210x297 mm)

Left margin: 2 cm. Right margin: 2 cm. Width of the written text: 17 cm.

Top margin: 3 cm. Bottom margin: 2.7 cm. Height of the written text: 24 cm.

Footer: use a footer xxx.y with xxx the paper log number and y the page number

Interline spacing: single spacing (12 points), except in lists like this (+6 points)

Paragraph indentation: none.

The abstract, Introduction, Conclusion and References sections should be present in the paper. Only sections and subsections headings are allowed.

Fonts: 12 points Times and Symbol in the whole paper, except in the paper title (14 point bold). Bold face is only used in the paper title and the section headings. Italic face is only used in 1) authors affiliation and address, 2) sub-section headings and 3) book titles in references.

No page numbers or running headers should be used (this is critically important).

## 2.1 Paragraph formatting

Equations should be centered and have the number flushed to the right of the formula:

$$\frac{dN}{dt} = \frac{r - b}{\Lambda} N + \sum_i I_i C_i \quad (1)$$

The continuation of a paragraph after an equation is not indented. Equations should be referenced in the text by Eq. (x). All paragraphs, as well as section or subsection headings, are separated by just one single empty line.

## 2.2 Figures and Tables

Figures and Tables should be referenced in the text (by Fig. x and Table y), and the captions should be centered below the figure or above the table. Use a single empty line after and before figures or tables. Examples are:

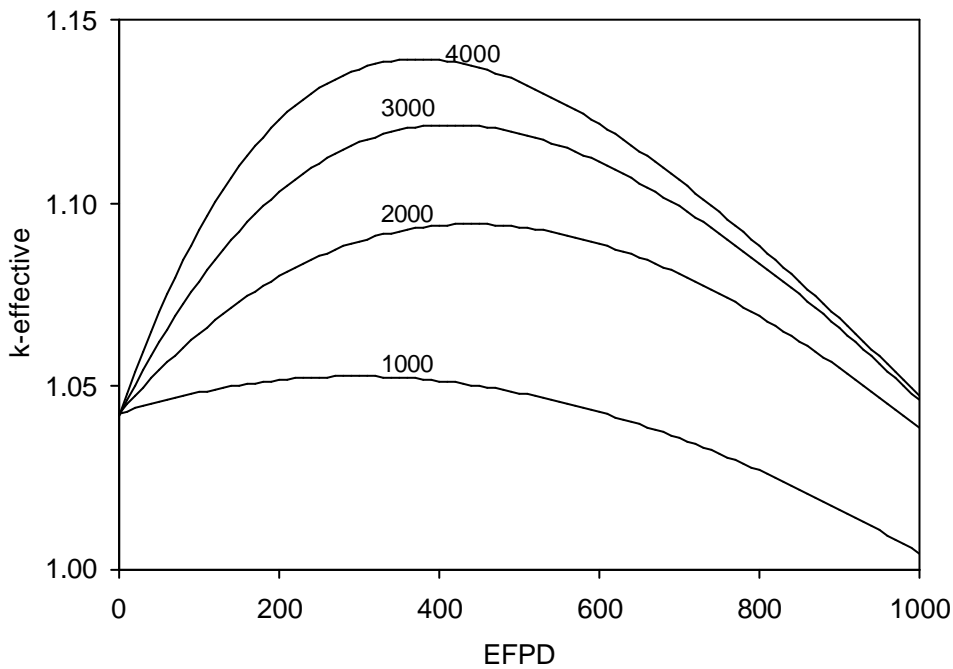


Figure 1. Example figure. The figures are printed without color!

When importing figures or any graphical image be sure of two things. First that any number, text or symbol is in Times font and is not smaller than 10 points after reduction to the actual window in your paper. Second that it can be converted to a pdf file, since for the book and the CD-ROM publishing we need to write your paper as a pdf file. To check this, please convert your paper to a pdf file and then read it entirely with the Acrobat 4.0 Reader.

If you use another word processor than MS-Word-97, you should always submit us the pdf file, so please check it with the Acrobat 4.0 Reader.

### 2.3 References

References are inserted in the text by writing between parentheses the author's name and year of publication. As example (Knief, 1992) or (Ueki et al., 1999). Order them alphabetically at the end of the paper (see below).

### 3. Paper length

A paper should not exceed 10 pages or 5 Mb pdf file. Papers exceeding 10 papers will not be included in the Conference book but only in the CDROM version, unless a payment of 100 Euros per extra page over 10 is done with an early registration before June 15, 2000.

### 5. Conclusions

This section should be present in every paper. Ongoing research (if any) is mentioned in this section too.

#### A. Appendix

Appendix is optional and must be referenced in the text, numbered by capital letters.

#### Acknowledgements

This section is intended to mention people who contributed to the research or to writing the paper.
